Thank you for enrolling in Sonja's Studio classes. We are so excited and happy to spend time together advancing our love of the performing arts. In an effort to keep our staff and community safe, we ask that you help us in keeping everyone healthy.

If you or your student are sick: PLEASE STAY HOME.

Guidelines are subject to change depending on the COVID pandemic status.
We do our best to follow state guidelines.

Participants must agree not to participate in a studio class if they:

1. Are exhibiting the current CDC recognized symptoms consistent with COVID.
2. Have knowingly been in contact with a confirmed case of COVID and are exhibiting symptoms.
3. Are living with someone with COVID who you cannot quarantine away from.
4. Have tested positive for COVID in the last 5 days.

Quarantine duration will follow state guidelines.

If a student/teacher tests positive for COVID and Sonja's Studio finds it necessary to cancel class with the intent to stop the spread, that class may have to be canceled for up to a week while symptoms are monitored. This will be dealt with on a class-by-class basis. Tuition will not be reimbursed for such closures.
